Description: This course provides the knowledge and skills needed to operate and perform preventive maintenance on a wildland fire apparatus. Topics include routine tests, inspections, and servicing functions on the systems and components unique to wildland fire apparatus; operating a wildland fire apparatus; and producing an effective fire stream.

In addition, students will experience tilt table effects and complete in rollover simulations. Students will learn about recovery techniques and off-road troubleshooting.

Prerequisites: Valid Class C License with FF Endorsement or Commercial Class A or B and CSFM FF I or appointed to the rank of Officer.

Proof of completion of prerequisites will be required on the first day of class to attend course
